



THE MEMORANDUM OF MAPEERA LOURDEL & UGANDA MARTYRS DURY PILGRIMAGE EUROPE

1. Name:

Mapeera Lourdel & Uganda Martyrs Dury Pilgrimage Europe, in short MUMADUPE.

2. Motto :

Super Omnia Caritas (Okwagala Kukira Byonna/Charity Above All)

3. Symbols:

Three Crosses – Representing the The Holy Trinity and Catholic Faith introduced to Uganda and the Great Lakes Region by Pere Mapeera and his confreres; Gold Colour – representing God’s Kingdom; White Colour – representing Holiness and White Fathers/Missionaries of Africa to which Mapeera belonged; Red Colour – representing martyrdom and Uganda, the country of Martyrs; Uganda Martyrs Icon – Mapeera’s spiritual children honoured by MUMADUPE; Dury Village on the map of France – representing the Birth Place of Mapeera and the MUMADUPE Place of Pilgrimage; Pens – representing schools, hospitals and development initiated by Mapeera and his confreres.

4. Mission:

Mapeera Lourdel & Uganda Martyrs Dury Pilgrimage Europe (MUMADUPE) is a group whose Mission is to promote the devotions and celebrations of Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera with his four confreres and of the Uganda Holy Martyrs in Europe, by principally organising pilgrimages to Dury-France, which would be called Mapeera And Martyrs Dury Pilgrimages, preferably on the third weekends of February and June.

5. Objectives:

1. To praise and thank God for the gift of Faith, for Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera, Frere Amans Delmas and their companions, for the Uganda Holy Martyrs, and for all other blessings to Uganda, Rwanda, Tanzania, Congo, Burundi, Kenya, etc., through all missionaries.
2. To annually organise, preferably over the Weekends of the third Sundays of February and June, pilgrimages to Dury-France for Christians living in Europe, mainly from Uganda, Rwanda, Congo, Tanzania, Burundi, Kenya, Tanzania, in honour of Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera, Frere Delmas Amans and their companions, and in honour of the Twenty Four Uganda Holy Martyrs.
3. To annually commemorate the martyrdom of the Uganda Holy Martyrs, and to venerate them.
4. To celebrate Catholic Faith Anniversaries for Uganda and for other Middle Africa countries whose evangelisation spread from Mapeera's mission – Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, Tanzania, Congo, Kenya
5. To promote the cause of the beatification and canonisation of Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera, the Apostle of Uganda, and his companion - Frere Delmas Amans.
6. To strengthen the Faith of the pilgrims to Dury; to promote the Christian Faith in the families and communities of the pilgrims, and in Europe; and to pray for individual and collective blessings.
7. To unite and celebrate as Spiritual grandchildren of Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera from Uganda, Rwanda, Tanzania, Kenya, Burundi, Congo, etc...and; to promote and celebrate the spiritual and brotherly relationship which was started by Pere Simeon Lourdel Mapeera and his companions, among Ugandans, Africans and the peoples of Europe.

6. MUMADUPE Supporting Groups and Affiliation

MUMADUPE is an initiative of Christ-The-King Uganda Catholic Fraternity, Christ-The-King Rwanda Catholic Fraternity and Our Lady's Middle Africa Catholic Archfraternity. It invites other willing Europe based Ugandan, Rwandese, Tanzanian, Congolese and Kenyan Catholic groups in Europe to promote its Mission. It shall seek to affiliate to and/or collaborate with the Mapeera and Amans Beatification Promoters' Association (MAB-PRO), in Uganda.

7. MUMADUPE Committee

MADUPUMAVE Committee is made of the Moderator, Secretary, Treasurer and Elder of every MADUPUMAVE Participating Group. Its Chair annually rotates among its Participating Group Moderators. Currently its Chair is held by Christ-The-King Uganda Catholic Fraternity. It may set up any required roles and annually appoint to them Office Bearers from its members.
